

How are the school zones defined?

The Board passed policy, No. 5116 in July of 2007, directing the Superintendent to establish zones in Hartford to enhance transportation and school choice.

The criteria used to determine a zone include: equal balance of the grouping of schools (Elementary, Middle and High Schools); sensitivity to cultural and historical neighborhoods; districted around any existing infrastructural barriers (Parks, etc.); existing boundaries.
