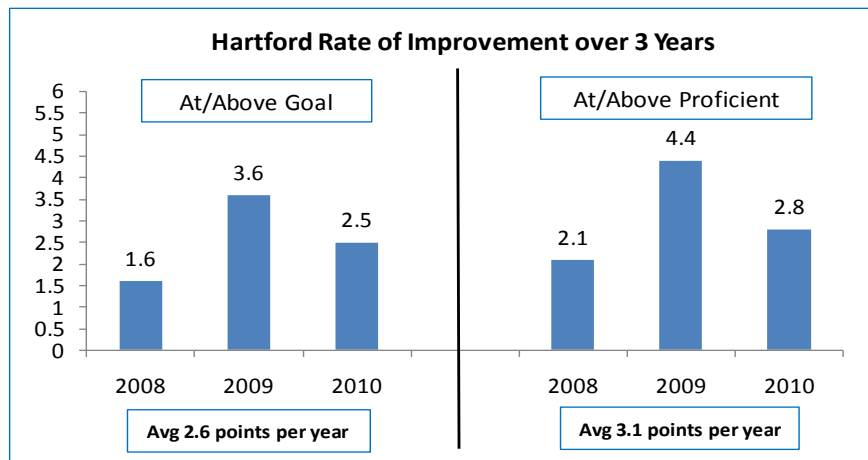
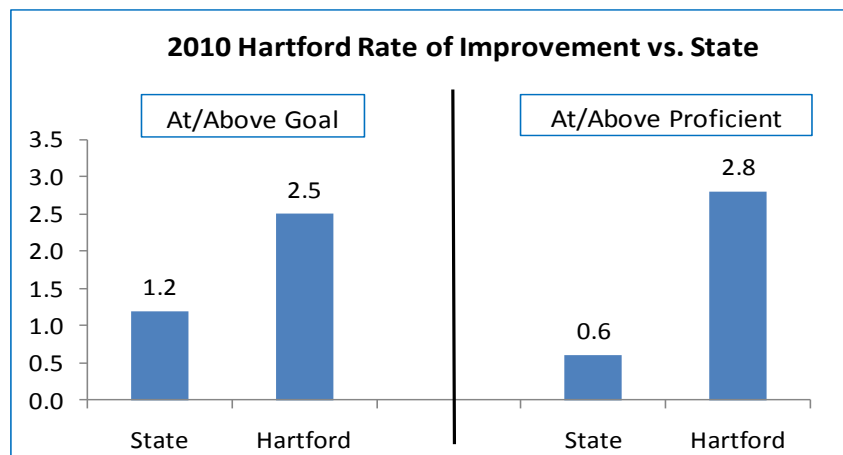


## Hartford Public Schools - 2010 CMT Snapshot

The Connecticut Mastery Test (CMT) is administered to all students in the 3rd to 8th grades annually. The information below summarizes Hartford's performance over the last three years (per state reported data) and compares Hartford to state averages. Due to its lower performing status, we believe it is equally important for Hartford schools to measure the performance of their students at both the Goal and Proficient levels to better gauge progress.



- The percent of students performing in 2010 at/above Goal increased by 2.5 points over 2009.
- Relative to at/above Proficient, Hartford increased by 2.8 points.
- The last three years have demonstrated an average yearly improvement of approximately 3 points at both Goal and Proficient.
- Given that Hartford still trails the State average by 25 points in the at/above Proficiency category, it will take Hartford approximately 8 years at its present three year average to close the achievement gap.



- Another way to put Hartford in context with the State is to compare their respective rates of improvement. Outperforming the State in this measure over the last three years is what has enabled Hartford to begin to slowly close the achievement gap.
- In 2010, Hartford's gain was twice that of the rest of the State when measured using at/above Goal and approximately 4.5 times when measured using at/above Proficient.
