HARTFORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS CELEBRATES OPENING OF NORTH END ADULT EDUCATION SITE

- What:** Grand opening of Hartford Public Schools North End campus
- When:** 12 noon, Monday, September 23, 2002
- Where:** 2550 Main Street, Hartford (former site of Phillips CME Church)
- Background:** Facility will offer adult education programs such as GED and ESL courses, adult basic education and adult credit diploma programs. Fully staffed with certified teachers and support services for the community, the site will also have a library, computer lab and conference rooms that will be available for community use. In addition, courses in automotive technology, computer instruction and preparation for police and fire officer exams will be provided.

The facility was purchased with Hartford Public Schools Board of Education funds. A YO! Academy will also be housed at the site; the Capital Region Workforce Development Board will rent the space for the academy.
