Special Education Files To Be Destroyed

(November 7, 2006) – In accordance with Section 7-109 of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Hartford Public Schools will destroy special education files and medical records at the end of December 2006 for students who have graduated or reached the age of 21 prior to 1999. These records are no longer needed to provide educational services; however, they may be needed by the student or parents for Social Security benefits or other purposes.
