Classical Magnet School Honored as a Shining Star School

(November 16, 2007) – Today the Hartford School System will honor Classical Magnet School as a “Shining Star” school at a reception for the school’s staff members. “Shining Star” schools are identified as those in which the majority of students achieved goal range or high proficiency range scores in the most recent Connecticut Academic Performance Test (CAPT) or Connecticut Mastery Test (CMT). Classical Magnet School achieved the goal range, in which more than 70 percent of students passed their respective standardized tests.

“Today we recognize the role all members of the Classical Magnet School team bring to raising student achievement,” said Steven J. Adamowski, Superintendent of the Hartford School System. “The success of this Shining Star school was truly the result of a collaborative team effort, from teachers to administrators to all support staff.”

Classical Magnet School is the first of eleven schools to be recognized this year for its success.
