Bulkeley High School opened in 1926 and was named after Morgan Gardner Bulkeley, President of the Aetna Insurance Company, first President of the National Baseball League, Governor and Senator of CT, Abolitionist, and tireless advocate for equal rights for all. The Bulkeley High School community believes that all students can become responsible, independent individuals possessing the academic, social, and civic competencies for the 21st century. We value high academic standards, individualized learning experiences, and specialized programs of study that meet the needs of a diverse student population.

Bulkeley High School has a Freshman Academy that is designed to provide support and services to ensure all students entering 9th grade successfully matriculate into their sophomore year. Current research indicates that a student who successfully passes 9th grade on their first try has a 91% chance of graduating high school in four years. Because of this, we are dedicated to providing students with whatever supports necessary to ensure success during their freshmen year. Freshmen Academy offers additional support in Math and English, a seminar class to enhance executive functioning and self-advocacy skills, and a dedicated team of teachers who are trained in student-centered learning. The Freshmen Academy team believes in working collaboratively with students and their families to establish a path to success.
