GET TO KNOW US

- Capital Prep's culture of high expectations is promoted weekly at all school events, where students in 15 grades come together to celebrate each other as one community.
- 5th grade, 8th grade and 12th grade students complete a Social Justice Project, which is a performance-based task where students will demonstrate their ability to question, research, lead, act, present and reflect, in order to confront a social injustice in their community.
- Capital Prep is a member of the National Honor Society and has a Junior National Honor Society for Students.
- Partnerships with the National Conference for Community and Justice, and Wee The People support staff and student development of essential qualities and characteristics for effective social justice leadership.
- Capital Prep hosts an annual Social Justice Conference to showcase exemplary student capstone social justice projects. Local advocacy groups provide opportunities to interact and share resources.

ACCOLADES

CURRICULUM

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
