ABOUT US

McDonough Middle School has over 400 students with grade-level teaming, thus creating smaller communities of learners within a traditional middle school. Spanish, Music, Art and PE support our core curricula of Math, Social Studies, Science and ELA. Athletics, Language, Expeditionary Learning and our Community School Model are what sets McDonough apart in fostering excellence within our school community.

At McDonough, we practice student-centered learning and interdisciplinary expeditions where students conduct authentic field research and present their work in meaningful ways.

We will be a fully functioning community school in January 2020, when we launch an extensive partnership with Catholic Charities. They will be providing clinical support during the school day and after-school programming to support our students.

McDonough Middle School has a pathway for students attending Parkville, Sanchez and ELAMS. These students do not need to apply to attend McDonough. All other students can access McDonough through the Hartford District Choice application.
