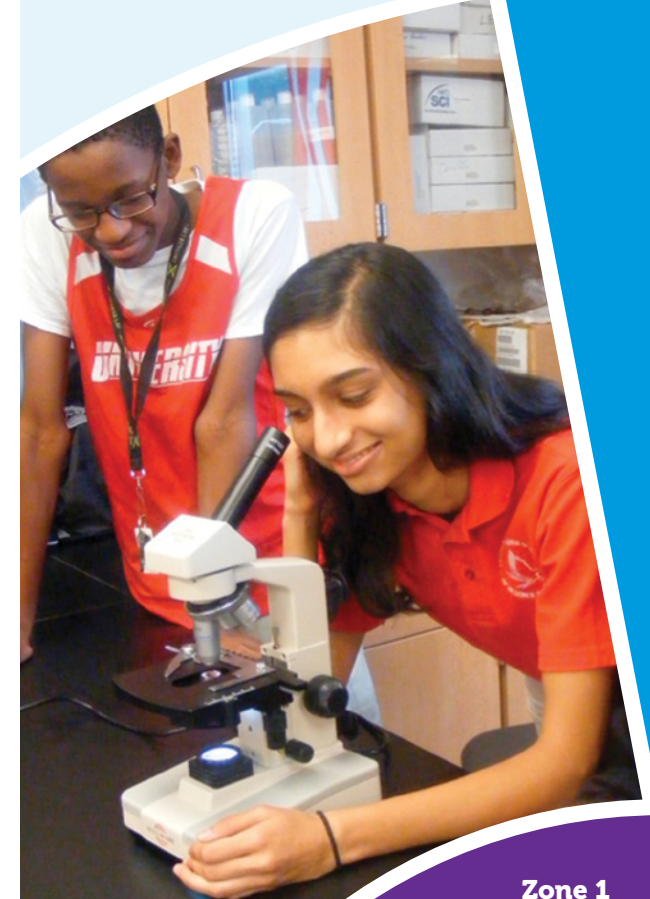

- Students are able to prepare for college by earning tuition-free college credits through UHSSE's partnerships with the University of Hartford, UConn, and the University of New Haven.
- Qualified students gain college credit by enrolling in Advanced Placement (AP), Early College Experience (ECE), and Project Lead the Way (PLTW) courses.
- The rigorous curriculum incorporates STEM components into core classes, including Language Arts and Social Studies, while also extending the theme into extracurricular activities.

CURRICULUM

All courses are taught at the honors and college level following the University of Hartford calendar and college schedule. Students are immersed in the STEM theme, with Science, Engineering and Math courses each year.
