Capital Community College is offering our 6th annual **Summer Computer Science Program** for middle school students aged 12-16. The Summer Computer Science Program provides a *stimulating, active, and fun learning environment* for students to explore and learn computer science through hands-on activities.

Capital's Summer 2019 Computer Science Program is a **two-week program** scheduled for:

July 8th – July 19th, 2019
8:30am–4:00pm

Topics to be covered over the two-week program include:

Mobile App Development
Learn fundamentals of computer programming through designing and developing Android apps.

Webpage Design
Design and code webpages using HTML, CSS and JavaScript.

Additionally, students will participate in youth development and leadership activities to build:

- ★ Teamwork and Collaboration Skills
- ★ Problem-Solving/Critical Thinking Skills
- ★ Presentation Skills



Program Cost

The Summer Computer Science Program costs **\$250** per student. Need-based scholarships are available for Hartford and East Hartford residents. Participating students are provided lunch each day throughout the program.

Transportation

Participating students must have their own transportation to and from the college. Student Drop-Off begins at 8:10am. Student Pick-Up is between 4:10 and 4:30pm.

Application Process

Who Can Apply?

The Summer Computer Science Program is designed BOTH for students with no knowledge of computer science, and for students with previous knowledge. Previous knowledge is not required - what is required is an interest and eagerness to learn.
