


How Do I Turn On My Device and Connect to the Internet?


Step 1: Power On Your Device

Chromebook or Windows Laptop



Turn on your device by pressing the power button on the back-right corner of the keyboard


Tablet or Phone:





Turn on your device using the power button. It may be located on the side or top of the device.


Step 2: Connect to the Internet


Chromebook or Windows Laptop:




On the bottom right corner of the screen you will see

If you see  , click on it, then click on the internet you want to join. Then, click connect.

If you see  , you are connected to the internet.



Tablet or Phone:



On the top of the screen, look for these symbols:


 This means you have cell service. This means you are connected to the internet.

If you do not have either of these signals, you will need to go into settings on your phone and look for Wi-Fi.

Step 3: Charging Your Device

Chromebook or Windows Laptop



Charge your device by plugging the power cord into the charging port on the side or back of the device.

Tablet or Phone:



Charge your device by plugging the power cord into the charging port on the bottom or side of the device.
